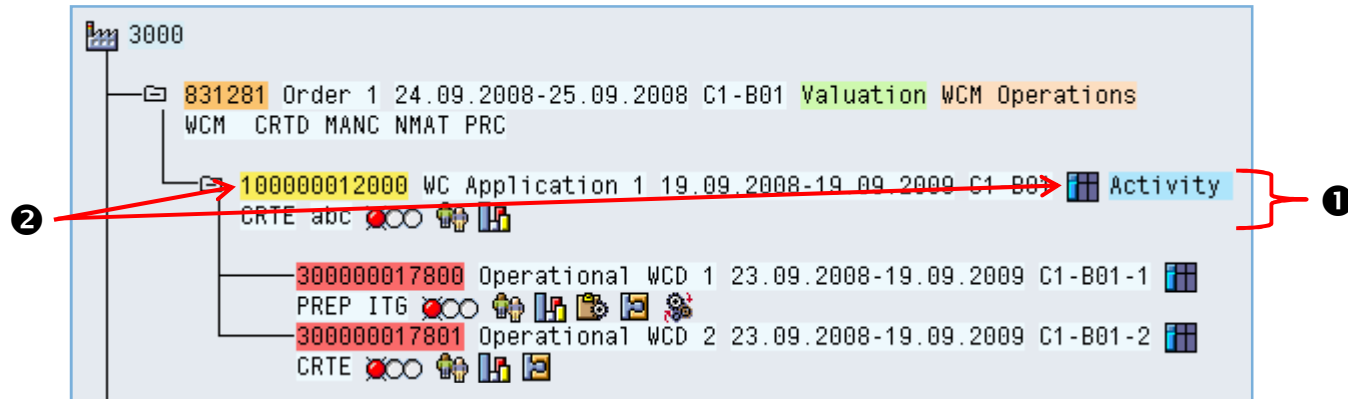
☒ Operational Lists

❶ To be able to choose, filters are placed.

❷ View is determined on the entry screen.

If you often use the same selection criteria to create lists, you can save these criteria as selection variants that follow special naming conventions. These selections are then automatically proposed when you call up the transactions.

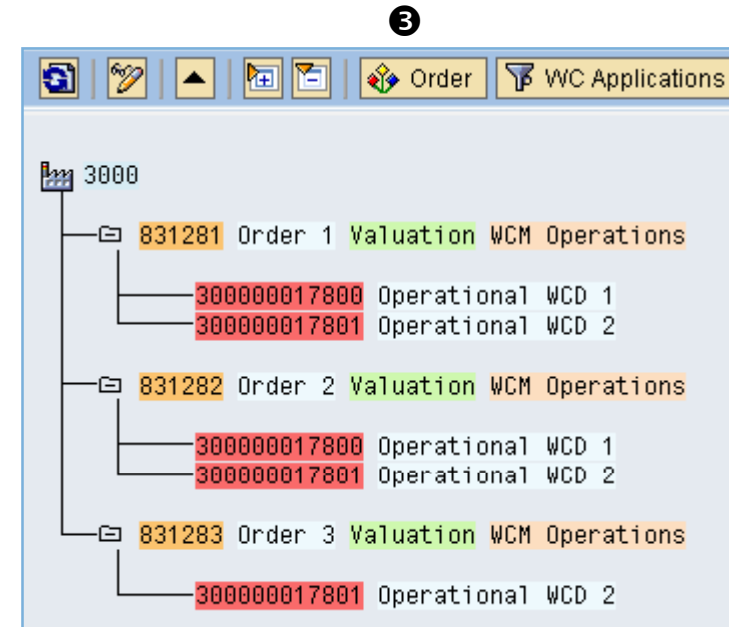
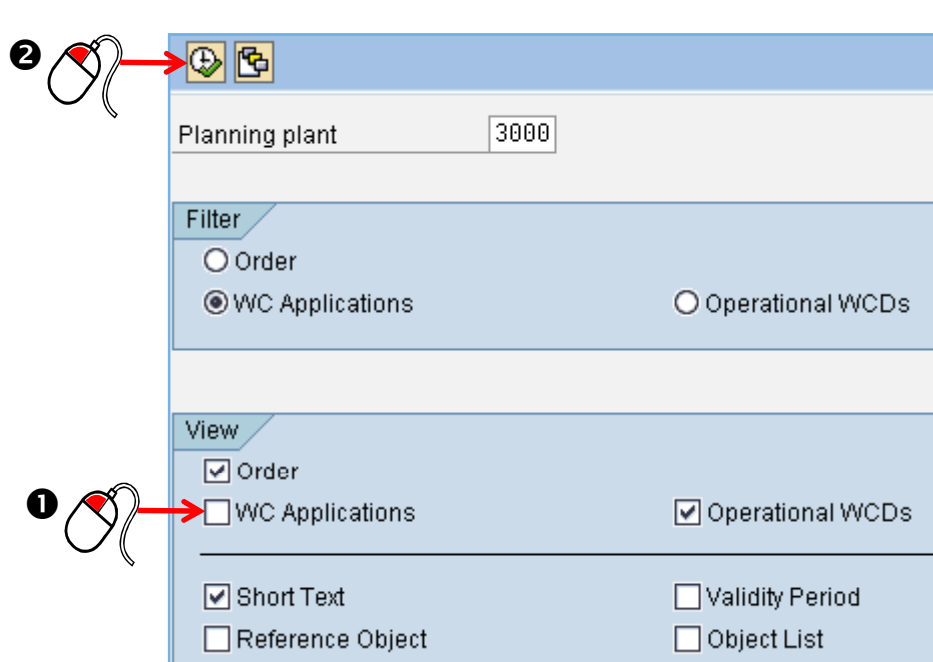
Multilevel List Processing Output Screen

- ❷ You can display header and additional data (e.g. object list).

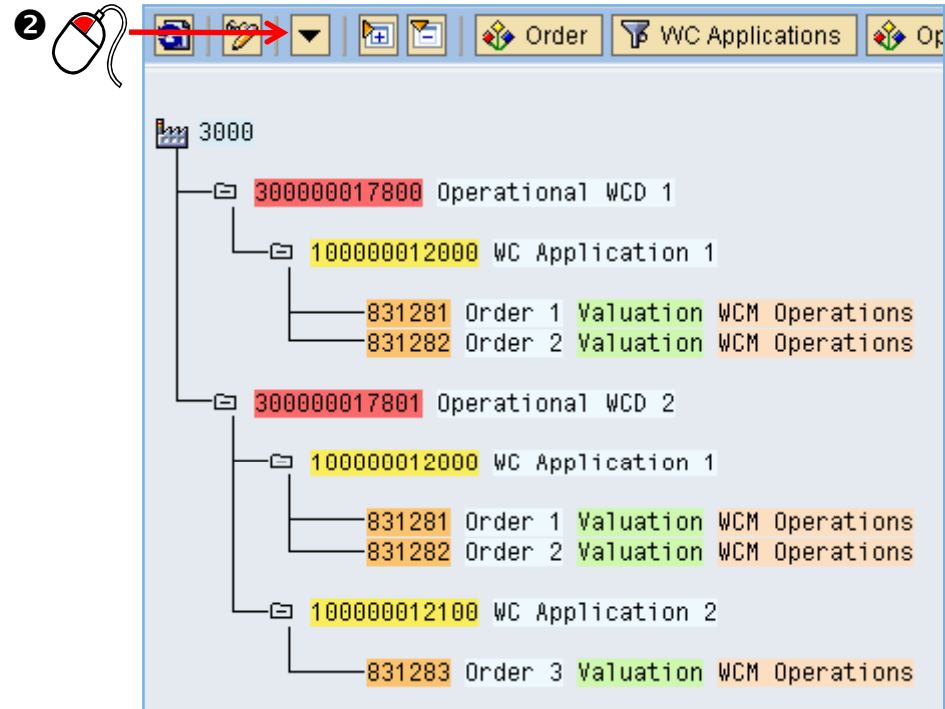
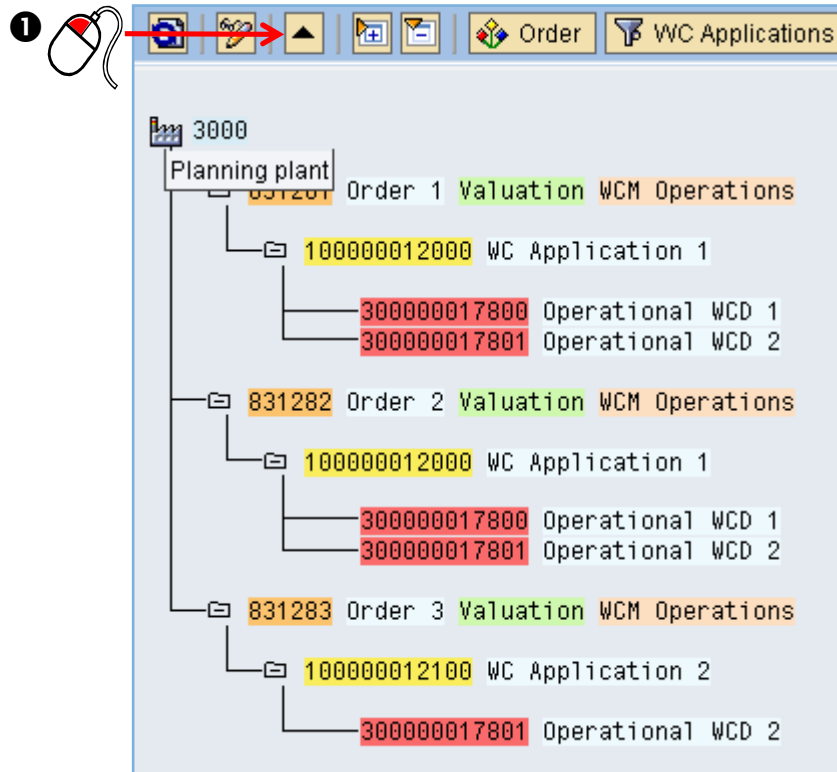
The view controls the layout of the list.

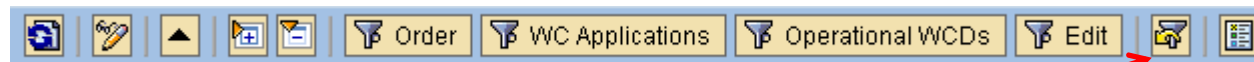

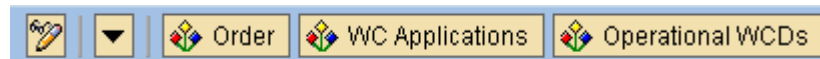

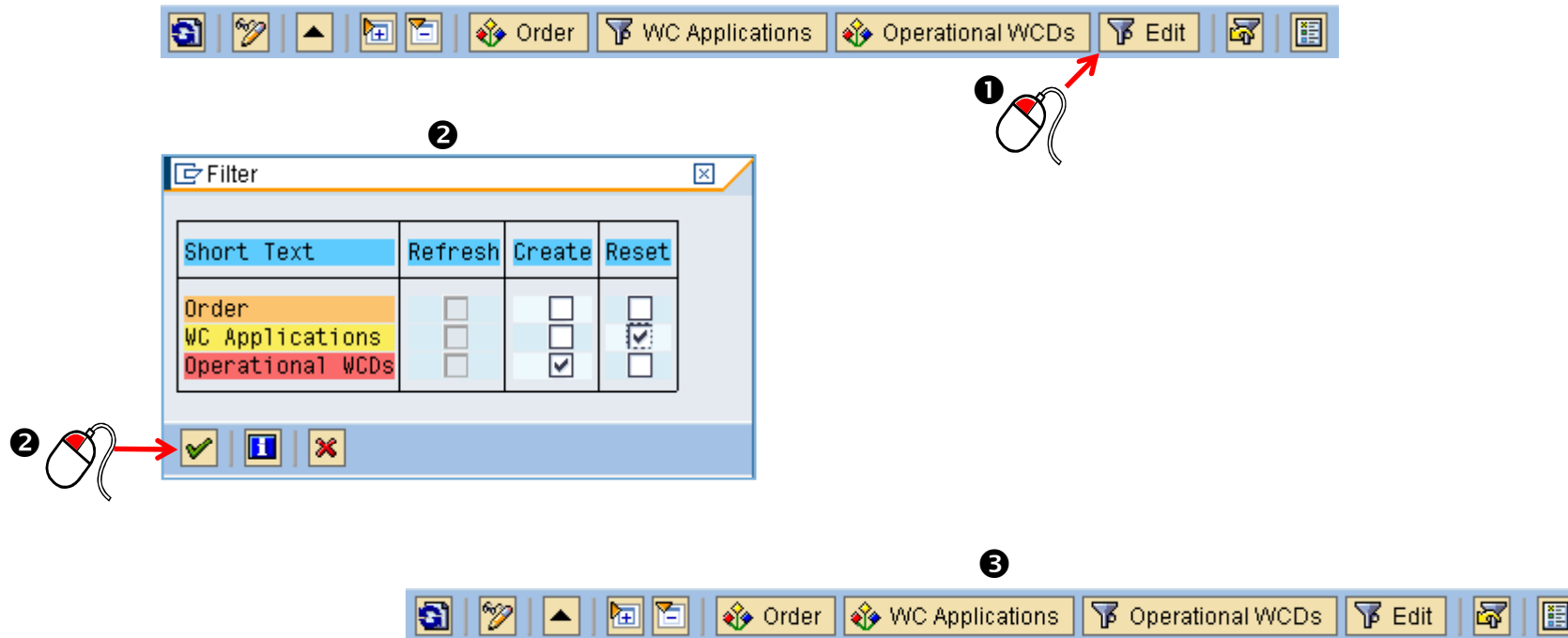



Edit Filters – Switch Filters



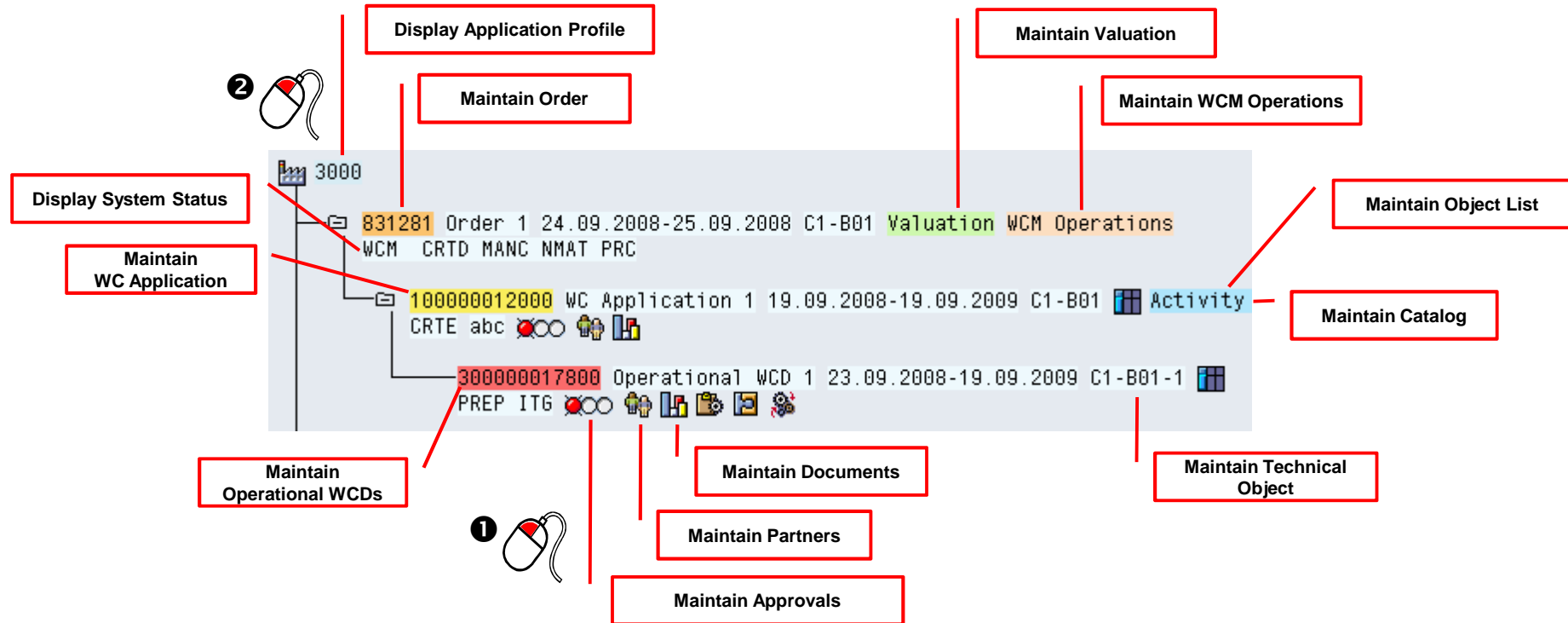
❶ To edit the filters, choose in the submenu **Filter** the entry **Edit Filter**. You find the submenu in the menu **Edit**.

❷ Highlight the filter you create or want to set back and press in the dialogue window the button **Continue**.

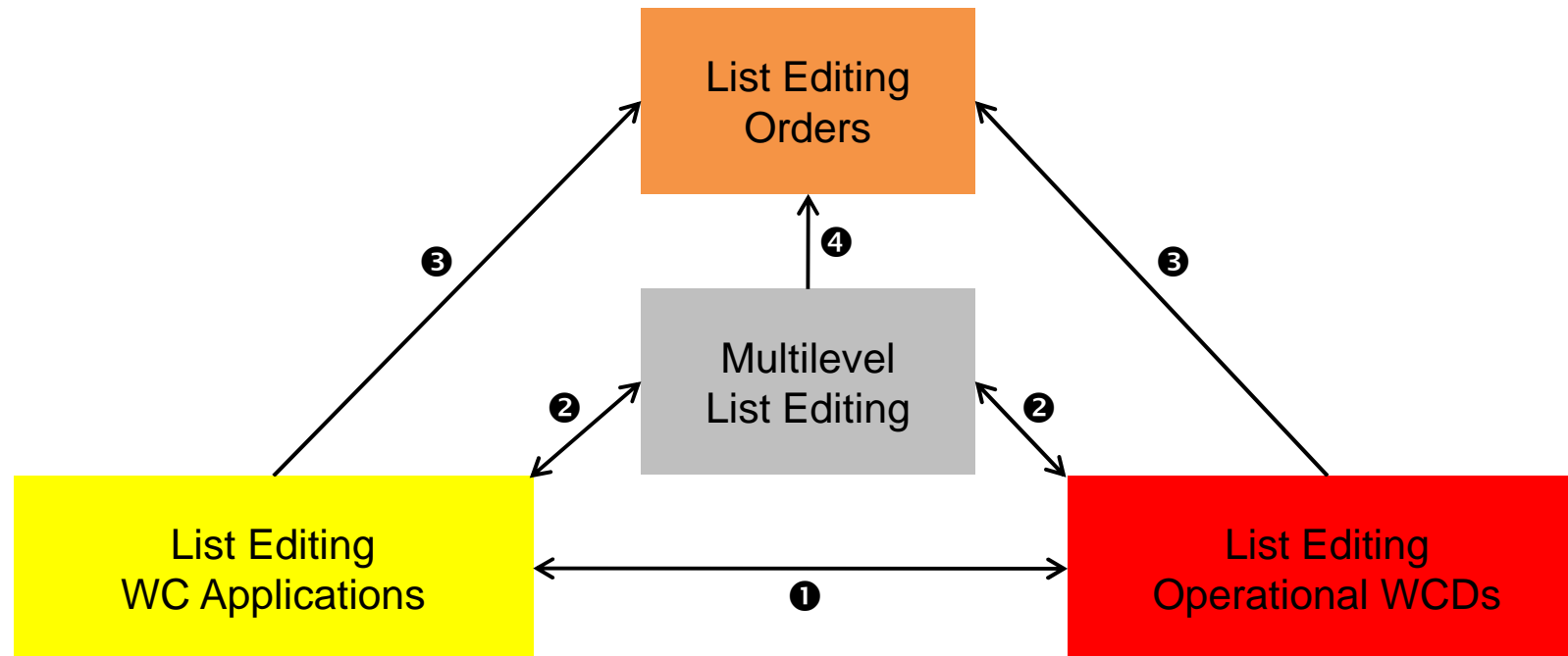
❸ The filters have been changed.

- ❷ Click on the planning plant.

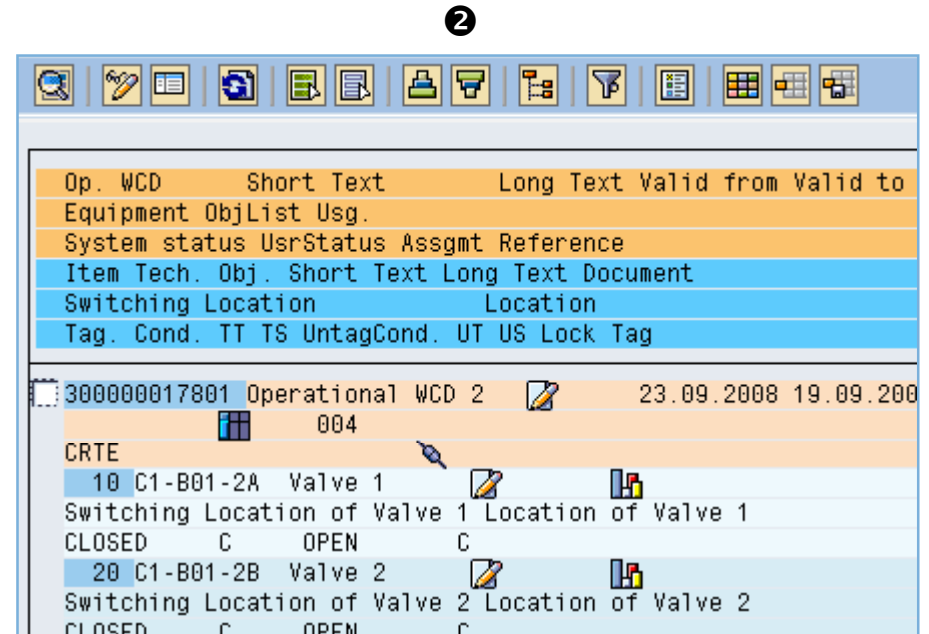
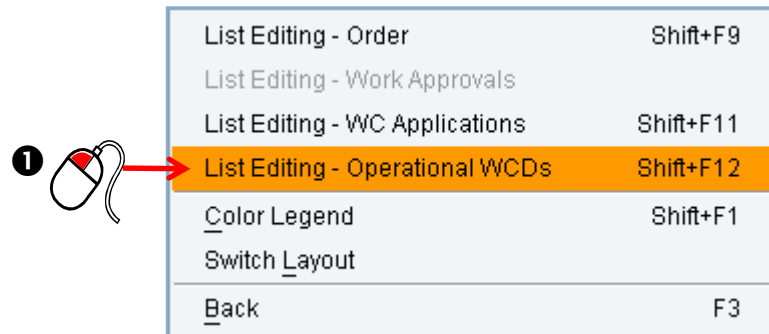
List Processing Navigation – Switch List Processing



- ❶ You can change between the single-level list editing of a WCM object to the single-level list editing of another WCM object.
- ❷ You can change between the single-level list editing of a WCM object to the multilevel list editing and vice versa.
- ❸ You can change between the single-level list editing of a WCM object to the single-level list editing orders.
- ❹ You can change between the multilevel list editing to the single-level list editing orders.

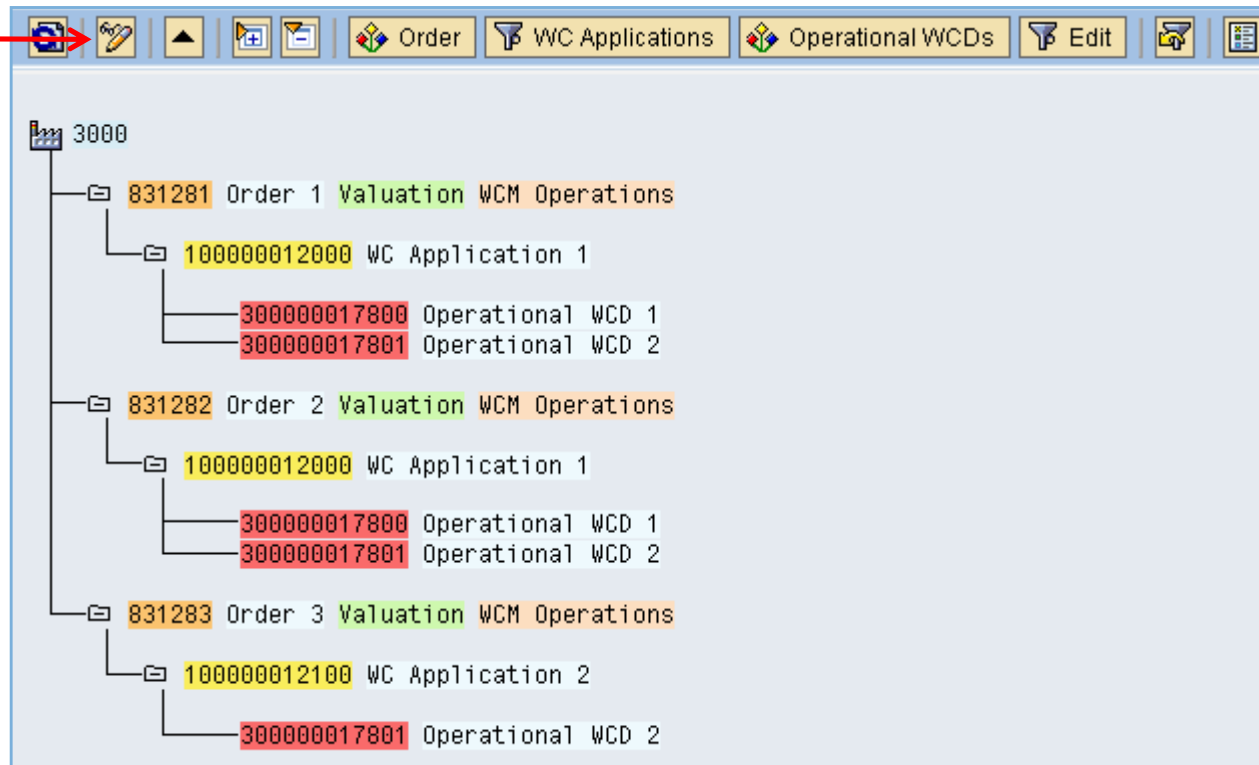
Switch to List Editing – Operational WCDs

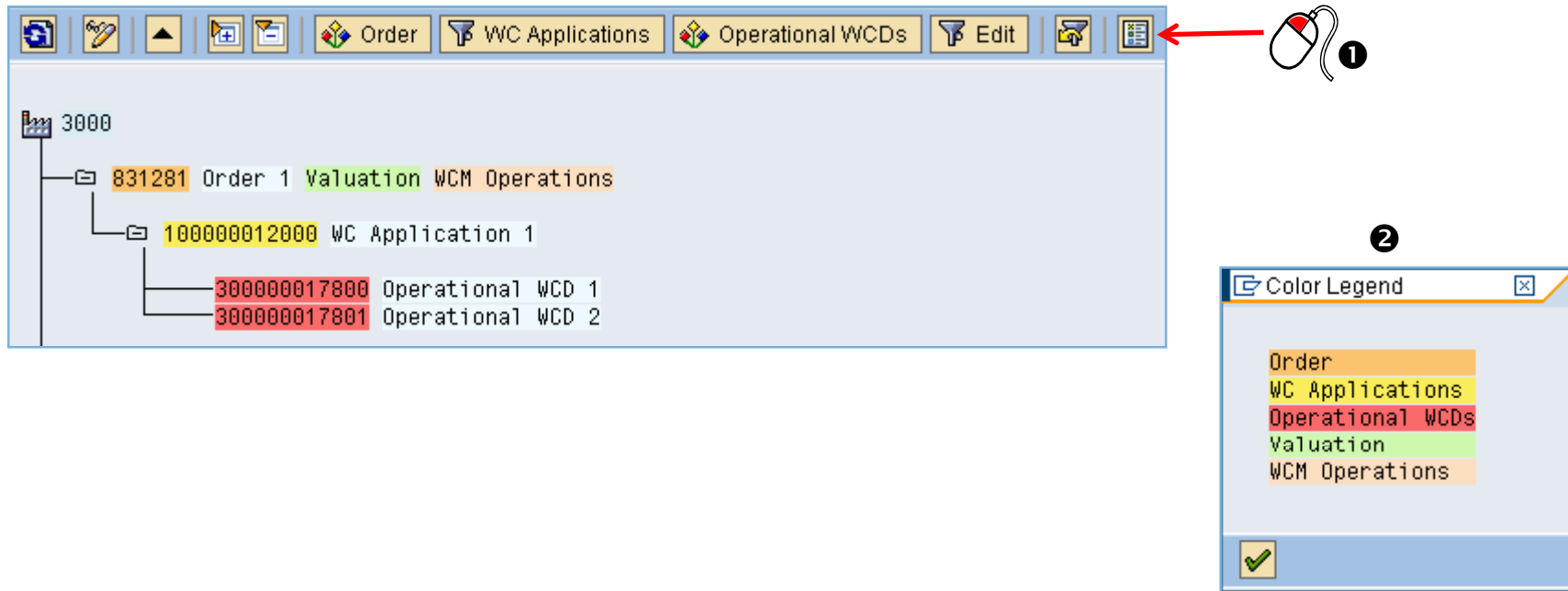


❶ To change to the editing mode, press the button
